

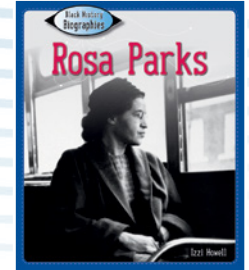
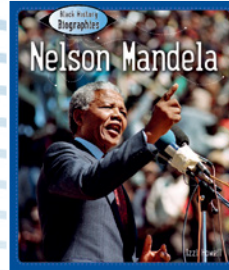
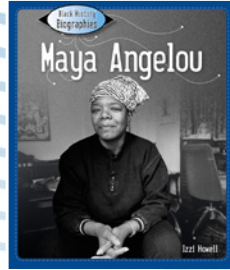
Black History Biographies
